

Don't Trash Your Recycling!



Trash and recycling bins are collected separately because they go to different places. The trash bin's contents are hauled off and end up in a local landfill. On the other hand, the recycling bin's contents are taken to a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) where the contents are separated by type, and then taken to factories for recycling.

When trash gets put in the recycling bins, it can contaminate the recyclables rendering them useless. The contaminated materials then have to be hauled to the landfill. Trash mixed into the recyclables also has to be pulled out at the MRF, making the work much more intensive and expensive.

You can help your environment and community by placing only recyclable materials mentioned in this brochure into your recycling bin and placing everything else into your trash bin.

CARDBOARD AND PAPER

Please flatten boxes and remove liners from cereal/food boxes.



PLASTIC CONTAINERS

No Styrofoam
No plastic bags



METAL CANS AND TRAYS

Rinse items before recycling.
Note: aerosol cans must be empty of pressure and product.



GLASS CONTAINERS

Food jars and beverage bottles
Please remove lids and rinse before recycling.
