

**Instructions for completing an
Application for Lower Colorado Water Supply Project Water**

ITEM

1. List the assessor's parcel number for which this application is being submitted. **NOTE:** A separate application must be submitted for each parcel of land for which you would like to have an entitlement to use Colorado River water now, or in the future. It is important for you to fill out an application whether or not the actual diversion facility is located on your parcel of land.
2. If you are submitting additional applications to receive Project water for other parcels of land, attach to the application a list of the assessor parcel number(s) on a separate sheet of paper.
3. Provide the mailing address for the parcel of land for which the application is being submitted, if applicable.
4. Provide the legal description of the parcel of land for which the application is being submitted. This should include the lot number, if appropriate, the section, township, and range designation for the parcel of land.
5. Provide the owner's name, mailing address, etc., as requested on the application. If there are additional owners, that information needs to be provided on the application or attached to the application on a separate sheet of paper.
6. Indicate whether the owner or another party lives on or uses this parcel of land on a regular basis or whether this parcel of land is not developed at this time and no one lives on it. If another party lives on or uses this parcel of land, fill in the requested information.
7. Indicate the date this parcel of land was acquired.
8. Indicate the date this parcel of land was developed. The term "developed" is meant to apply to the addition of improvements to vacant land and can include: a well being drilled, a manufactured home or house built on the parcel, a trailer house or mobile home moved on site, etc. **Be sure to provide documentation.** Documentation can include, but is not limited to: well log, receipt from a licensed well driller, city and/or county building/installation permit, Department of Motor Vehicle Registration for trailer house or mobile home, manufacture house or home, etc.
9. Indicate each source of water being used on this parcel of land and the date (month and year) water from that source was first used. If no water is currently used on this parcel of

land, but an application is being submitted for a future use, indicate the date (month and year) that it is anticipated the water will first be used. **NOTE: The date for a future use of water on this parcel of land should be your best estimate. It is recognized that conditions change and a firm date (month and year) may not be available at this time.** **Be sure to provide documentation.** If diversion or well was installed prior to November 15, 1986, Documentation can include, but is not limited to: well log reported to California Department of Water Resources; construction or installation agreement/receipt with a valid California licensed well driller or contractor; equipment purchase receipt; or other document that will show starting date of diversion or pumping.

10. Indicate the type of use for which water has been, or will be, used on this parcel of land. Check the appropriate types of water use and time period for which water has been used or will be used in the future. **NOTE: The type of water use may change from one time period to another. If that has occurred or is anticipated to occur, that fact should be indicated on this application.** **Be sure to provide documentation.** Documentation should include a brief description of past, present and anticipated type of uses for each time period.
11. Indicate in “a” the maximum annual (12 month period) quantity of water that has been diverted from the Colorado River or has been pumped from the groundwater aquifer and used on this parcel of land. As appropriate, the quantity of water should be listed in each time period, that is: i) prior to November 15, 1986; ii) between November 14, 1986, and November 13, 2001; and iii) after November 13, 2001. The quantity of water listed for the time period after November 13, 2001, should be the maximum annual quantity of water that is expected to be used on this parcel of land in the future and is the quantity of water for which you would apply for a subcontract. **Be sure to provide documentation.** Documentation should include a brief description of the method and facility for the diversion of water, i.e. pump and well size, motor horse power, pipe size, etc.

Indicate in “b” the estimated percentage of the water that was actually consumed. The amount of water that you divert is not all used. A portion of that water may return to the Colorado River. The amount of return flow depends upon type of use (residential, landscaping nursery, cooling water, etc.) and the means for disposing of wastewater (septic tank, natural drainage, evaporation ponds, etc.) Please provide a detailed description of water uses on this parcel, which may include: potable use, irrigation, pool, etc. for residential site or potable use, cooling water, etc. for industrial or commercial uses. Please indicate your estimate, as a percentage, of your actual or future consumptive use in Question 11(b). **Please provide some documentation on how this percentage was determined.**

12. Provide documentation showing the location of the diversion facility that is being used to obtain the water used on this parcel of land. **Be sure to provide documentation.** Documentation can include, but is not limited to: a map, illustration, and/or drawing that

clearly shows the location of the diversion facility in relationship to this parcel of land.

13. Indicate, if any, other parcels of land that are supplied by the diversion facility that was described in question 12. If there are several parcels of land, they should be listed on a separate sheet that is attached to the application. **Be sure to provide documentation.** Documentation should include the Assessor's Parcel Number as well as the legal description (lot number, if appropriate, section, township, and range).
14. Indicate the maximum capacity of the diversion facility in terms of a flow rate, such as, gallons per minute, cubic feet per second, or other acceptable unit of measure. Additional information may be provided, such as, well size, pipe size, etc.
15. Indicate if there is natural or propane gas service on the site.
16. Indicate if there is electrical service on the site.
17. Indicate if there is water service on the site. If the answer is "No", indicate the date that you expect to use Colorado River water on this parcel of land.
18. Indicate if there is sewer service on the site. **NOTE: The answer to this question is "yes" if waste water is collected and taken to a community or regional water treatment facility involving two or more parcels of land.**
19. Indicate if there is a septic tank on the site.
20. Indicate in "a" the quantity of water that you would like to subcontract with the City of Needles prior to the end of calendar year 2002 (December 31, 2002). You need to identify the annual numeric volume of water you expect to divert under the subcontract, (for example 10 acre-feet* per year).

Indicate in "b" the annual numeric volume of water that you expect to divert under a subcontract with the City of Needles after December 31, 2002 (for example 5 acre-feet per year). **NOTE: If you identified a volume of water in question 20(a) above, the quantity of water listed in 20(b) should be in addition to that quantity of water listed in question 20(a). However, if the quantity in 20(a) is zero, then the quantity of water listed in 20(b) should be the quantity of water for which you would like a subcontract.**

*One acre-foot of water is about 326,000 gallons of water.
